Who is sentenced to death in act I? - Answer ✓✓- The Thane of Cawdor because he was a traitor

Banquo- will be "lesser than Macbeth, and greater, not so happy, and yet happier" and his children will be kings

What news does Ross bring Macbeth in Act I? - Answer ✓✓- Macbeth now holds the title of the Thane of Cawdor

Banquo, like Macbeth, is surprised that the witches have predicted Macbeth's new title. He is, however, leery. What does he say about the motives of the "instruments of darkness"? - Answer ✓✓- They often tell of good things, which may happen without telling the bad consequences

Malcolm describes Cawdor's last moments before execution. What is Duncan's reply? - Answer ✓✓- You can't tell what is in a person's heart by looking at his face. (Things are not what they seem!)

Macbeth says, "Stars, hide your fires. Let not light see my black and deep desires." What are his desires? - Answer ✓✓- He now desires to be king, and he realizes that something will have to be done with the present king (and his sons) before his desires can become reality

After Lady Macbeth reads the letter, what does she tell us is her opinion of Macbeth, and how does she plan to help him? - Answer ✓✓- She thinks he could be a good king but lacks the hardheartedness and plans to talk him into it
