- 1) Command name
- 2) Full quote (no expansion)
- 3) Partial quote (allows variable and command expansion)
- 4) Bracelet (}
- 5) All arguments as a single word
- 6) with arguments as from 2 to 6
- 7) Use value for variable
- 8) Run jobs/ies in background
- 9) Escalate or substitute; output from multiple lines can be directed to one file by using this option
- 10) wildcard | approximates everything, eg. `ls /tmp/*` or with copy all files in the /tmp directory to the /etc directory
- 11) Single Period " ." - The current directory, used in `./command` to execute the file command
- 12) Double Period " .. " Parent Directory
- 13) `!command`
 - 1) Redo the script preparing the installed files for scripting
 - 2) Separate commands on same line
 - 3) Single character wildcard, eg. `cp *.conf /tmp` will copy all files beginning with the name conf, in the current directory to the directory named tmp.
 - 4) Match any characters enclosed
- 14) `{}` Choice of character wildcards, eg. `ls {a-z}` will list all files in the current directory starting with the letter a, b or z.
- 15) Quote the following character: used used to allow user what is not normally available on terminal, also used to break a command key over multiple lines
- 16) `{} back ticks {}` Substitute output of enclosed command
- 17) `{} pipe |` Takes the output and it becomes the input for the command after the pipe
- 18) Redirect input
- 19) Uses a delimiter with `>` to pass as input to a command, helpful for scripting programs such as ftp, telnet for user jobs.
- 20) Redirect output
- 21) Used to append data to another file. Example:
`ls -l >> myfile.txt`
This example will append the results of `ls -l` to the end of the file `myfile.txt`

Boot Information:

-GRUB

- 1) `grub` GRUB is the Grand Unified Bootloader. This name specifically provides the users support where it can use numerous all support to boot (options for the kernel, kernel, etc.). This allows you to have a configuration file associated and will be able to boot from a new kernel, change geometry on the drive, and change filesystem without problems. The GRUB boot loader gives you either a menu to choose pre-defined boot options from, or a command-line interface for custom boot options.
- 2) `grub> ls (hd0,1)`
Retrieves grub into the hard disk

-LSD

- 1) `lsd` LSD is Linux's older boot loader. LSD is typically in the BIOS, but can be installed in the MBR (1) partition. LSD cannot load beyond the first boot cylinder (8 GB) of the hard drive. To find the boot loader, UNLESS LBA mode is enabled.
- 2) `lsd -o disk`
set LSD default OS default-disk in the copy
- 3) `lsd -o boot`
LSD boot loader configuration file

Linux Kernel Boot Options

- 1) `linux boot options: kernel/linux` - Can read screen during boot prompt without password, can be used to fix some problems.
- 2) `linux boot options: initrd` - In the file prompt, start to single user mode. This is useful if you have forgotten your password. Best to single user mode, then run the `passwd` command.

Mount -- Options and Examples

- 1) `mount -t ext3 /dev/sda1 /mnt`
Mount the device `sda1` and call it `mnt` under the `/mnt` directory
- 2) `mount -t ext3 /dev/sda1 /mnt`
Mount hard disk `sd1` as a `ext3` file system and call it `mnt` under the `/mnt` directory
- 3) `mount -t ext3 /dev/sda1 /mnt`
Mount hard disk `sd1` as a `EXT3` file system and call it `mnt` under the `/mnt` directory
