Beginning with duration, a run that interferes excessively with my free time is frustrating and would not be my favorite. I do not mind setting aside the 10-12 hours per week that training takes; however, I admit that I like to do things other than just run, so I prefer the training runs that do not take up all my free time. My shortest runs are my speed and tempo runs, which I do after school, and which take only about 45 minutes to an hour to complete. These runs are a
