



## About the backup battery

To keep good time, a backup power source, like our new CR2032 battery inside, will act in addition to the main source.

The battery keeps the clock and the alarm operating in the event of a power interruption.

## Knowing when to replace the battery

Before the battery becomes weak, the "L" indicator appears on the display.

In the event of a power interruption when the battery is weak, the alarm tone and alarm functions will be disabled.

Replace the battery with a new CR2032 lithium battery. Use of another battery may present a risk of fire or explosion.

## Installing and replacing the backup battery

- 1 Cover the AC plug connected to the AC outlet, remove the cover that secures the battery compartment at the bottom of the unit using a screwdriver, and remove the battery compartment. (See Fig. 1-12)
- 2 Insert a new battery in the battery compartment with the (+) side facing up. To remove the battery from the battery compartment, push it out from the side marked "PUSH" (see Fig. 1-12).
- 3 Insert the battery compartment back into the unit and secure it with the screw. (See Fig. 1-12)
- 4 When you are replacing the battery's cover, **BADGE ON** (or "L") indicator will be on the display.

When you replace the battery, do not disconnect AC plug from AC outlet.

\* Otherwise, correct time and alarm will be maintained.

## When the display does not work

The display does not work about 1 minute after the operation is complete.

**Note**

Design the operation and press the unit, to check what may occur in this case, refer to "Setting the clock and date".

## When daylight saving time (summer time) begins

The following table shows the Automatic Daylight Saving Time (Summer Time) adjustment. The DST indicator in the display appears in the display at the beginning of the daylight saving time (summer time), and disappears at the end of summer time.

- 1 Daylight saving time begins on 04:00 AM on the second Sunday of March.
- 2 Standard time begins at 03:00 AM on the first Sunday of November.

## To cancel the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment and to set DST display manually

The Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment can be cancelled.

Press and hold **DST** for more than 3 seconds while the clock is displayed.

A beep sounds, and "Aut → OFF" appears in the display to show that the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is cancelled. The display returns to the clock.

**Note**

- 1 The change timing of Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment will be cancelled and will not be reflected by the operation and the set for each country/region. In each case, cancel the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment and set DST manually on the next day morning. The auto time in the company region that has not introduced the daylight saving time (summer time) will cancel Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment before using the unit.

- 2 To activate the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment again, press and hold **DST** for more than 3 seconds. A beep sounds, and "Aut → ON" appears in the display to show that the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is activated. The display advances the clock.

- 3 To change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) manually, set "On change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) indicator".

## Setting the clock and date

To change the setting manually, follow the procedure (see Fig. 1-13).

- 1 Press **DISPON** for more than 3 seconds. The unit will beep and the year will start to flash in the display.
- 2 Press **▲** or **▼** to set the correct year appears in the display.
- 3 Press **DISPON**.
- 4 Repeat steps 2 and 3 to set the month, day and time.

After setting the time, the alarm beep sound and the clock start from 3 seconds.

- 1 Pressing and holding a set → change the year, month or day again.
- 2 When setting the correct time, time changes rapidly by 1 minute increments, up to 59 minutes, and then by 10 minute increments.
- 3 While setting the clock, you set positions each step within 60 seconds, so the clock setting mode will be cancelled.

## To display the year and date

Press **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** once for the clock and within about 3 seconds press it again for the year.

The display shows the date or year for about 3 seconds and then changes back to the current time.

If you press the "set" plug in the unit while the unit is powered from the backup power source, the current date and time appears in the following order: (0) to (9) to set the year (the year is presented on when the power comes on), (1) to (9) to set the month (1 second) → (1) to (9) to set the day (1 second) → (1) to (9) to set the time (1 second).

## To change the display to the daylight saving time (summer time) indication

Change the daylight saving time (summer time) adjustment (change to the following) in the procedure if you have cancelled the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment.

Press **DST**.

DST indicator appears in the display and the time indication changes to the daylight saving time (summer time).

To deactivate the daylight saving time (summer time) adjustment, press **DST** again.

## Setting the brightness of the display

Three levels of brightness are available by pressing **BRIGHTNESS**.



## Playing the radio

- 1 Press **BADGE ON** to turn on the radio.
- 2 Adjust volume using **VOLUME**.
- 3 Select **BAND**.
- 4 Tune in to a station using **TUNING**.

## To turn off the radio

Press **BADGE OFF/ALARM RESET**.

## Improving the reception

**FM:**

The FM power cord functions as an FM antenna. Extend the FM power cord fully to improve reception sensitivity.



**AM:**

Extend the unit horizontally to optimize reception. A better FM AM antenna is built in to the unit.



Do not operate the unit over a metal desk or metal surface, as this may lead to deterioration of reception.

## Setting the alarm

The dual alarm function allows you to set two alarm programs (ALARM A and ALARM B).

The alarm tone and the radio program and the alarm sound is adjustable from **SOUND** or **BROADCAST**.

**Note**

- 1 Before setting the alarm, make sure to set the clock first "Setting the alarm time".
- 2 The factory setting alarm time is "FM (00:00)".
- 3 In set the radio alarm, first tune in to a station and adjust the volume (in "Playing the radio").
- 4 When you set the alarm alarm, set **ALARM VOLUME** to **SOFT** or **HEAVY**.

## To set the alarm time

- 1 Set **ALARM A (or B)** to the desired alarm sound (**CRACK** or **BUSINESS**). The alarm tone appears for a few seconds, and then the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator lights up in the display. (It does not appear when the switch is set to **OFF**.)

- 2 Turn **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** to **▲** or **▼** to set the desired time.

Each time of **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** is set → change the indication by 1 minute. If you press and hold **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** → the alarm time goes forward (or backward) by 1 minute up to 59 minutes, and then by 10 minute increments. While setting the alarm time, the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator flashes in the display. The following example is when setting the **ALARM A**.



When the alarm time setting operation is complete, the display returns to the clock after a few seconds and the **ALARM A (or B)** indicator changes from flashing to fully on.

- 1 While **ALARM A (or B)** is set to **BADGE** or **BUSINESS**, the alarm tone setting can be changed by **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)**.

For use of **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** display, the alarm tone for about 3 seconds, the setting **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** while the alarm time appears in the display, the alarm time will be changed.

- 1 The **ALARM A (or B)** indicator flashes in the display while:
  - The alarm time appears in the display.
  - The alarm mode is changed.
  - The alarm is turned on.
- 2 The alarm time setting screen is changed to **ALARM A (or B)** is set to **OFF**. If **ALARM TIME SET A (or B)** is turned, "DST" appears in the display for about 3 seconds.
- 3 If a second alarm sounds during a sleep (or the remote function is active), the second alarm volume priority.

- 1 **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** or **ALARM RESET** will cancel the alarm sound in the display function is turned on.
- 2 The **ALARM VOLUME** setting works together with the **ALARM SOUND**. If the **ALARM VOLUME** is set to **SOFT**, the alarm sound will be also set to **Low**.
- 3 The alarm function works as usual at the beginning and mid day of the daylight saving time (summer time) each. While the Automatic DST/Summer Time adjustment is set, as a result, if the alarm is set at a time stopped before the daylight saving time (summer time) begins, the alarm is stopped, or if the alarm is set at a time interrupted after the daylight saving time (summer time) ends, the alarm sounds twice.
- 4 If the same alarm time is set for both alarms, **ALARM A** and **B**, the **ALARM A** takes priority.

## To dose for a few more minutes

Press **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**.

The radio will stop and the daylight saving time (summer time) will stop after about 10 seconds. Each time you press **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**, the alarm time changes as follows:



The maximum length of the alarm time is 60 minutes.

The display shows the alarm time for about 3 seconds and returns to show the current time. When you press **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** after the alarm time appears, the alarm time starts from 30 seconds again.

## To stop the Alarm

Press **BADGE OFF/ALARM RESET** to turn off the alarm.

The alarm will cease on again at the next time the alarm rings.

If **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** is not pressed, the alarm sounds continuously for about 60 minutes, and then it will be stopped automatically.

## To deactivate the Alarm

Turn **ALARM A (or B)** to **OFF**.

**ALARM A (or B)** indicator disappears from the display.

Turn on alarm in the event of a power interruption

In the event of a power interruption, alarm functions work until the battery is empty. The following functions are different.

- 1 Display will disappear.
- 2 When the alarm sound is set to **BUSINESS**, it will change to **BUSINESS** automatically.
- 3 If the power returns while the alarm sounds, the alarm sounds continuously for about 60 minutes when the power returns.
- 4 The alarm function for about one minute stops temporarily, and will resume again after the alarm is turned on by pressing **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** or **BADGE OFF/ALARM RESET** on power while the alarm is sounding.
- 5 If the alarm function will stop automatically after a sleep (or the remote function is active), the alarm is stopped by pressing **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** or **BADGE OFF/ALARM RESET** on power. The alarm will flash for 30 minutes after power is restored if the power is restored within 60 minutes from the alarm time.
- 6 If you press **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF** while the alarm sounds, the alarm time is set to 30 minutes. During a power failure, the alarm time cannot be set to the alarm time 30 minutes.
- 7 If "DST" indicator appears in the display, the alarm will not work in the event of power interruption. Replace the battery if "L" indicator appears.

## Setting the sleep timer

You can fall asleep to the radio using the built-in sleep timer that turns off the radio automatically after a given duration.

Press **SLEEP**.

The radio turns on. You can set the sleep timer to duration of 30, 45, 60, or 90 minutes. Each time changes the display as follows.



The alarm/beep sound when the display returns to "00:00" will play for the duration you set, then shut off.

## To turn off the radio before the preset time

Press **BADGE OFF/ALARM RESET** or **SMOKE/DATE/SLEEP OFF**.

## To use both sleep timer and alarm

The built-in sleep timer and alarm will be turned off by the radio or (summer alarm at the preset time).

- 1 Set the alarm. (See "Setting the alarm".)
- 2 Set the sleep timer. (See "Setting the sleep timer".)
