

GASTROPODS

Gastropods are the largest group of mollusks with over 80,000 marine and freshwater species including snails, slugs, abalone, conches and many more. The typical gastropod has a flexible body enclosed in a spiral shell. The body can be extended when moving or feeding and withdrawn into the shell for protection. The gastropod body features a muscular foot used for locomotion and a defined head with two to four tentacles with eyes. They may be herbivores or carnivores. Many have a structure called a radula which they use to bore holes through the shells of other mollusks they feed on.



Circled Rocksnail (CAS)

Comesoma circumdata
To 1 in. (2 cm) high
White to grayish shell has prominent ridges and spine bands with brown blotches. Feeds on diatoms.



Common Northern Moon Snail (B,CR)

Polinices limax
To 1 in. (2.5 cm) high
Rounded shell is gray-white to brownish, used to refer to bore holes in timbers.



Black Top Shell (W)

Lupinus lamellosus
To 1 in. (2.5 cm)
Rounded, thick black shell usually has an eroded apex.



Shark Eye (E)

Neverita albigula
To 3 in. (8 cm) high
Cone-shaped shell is black to brownish-gray. Feeds on clams.



Ribbed Top Shell (W)

Calliostoma ligatum
To 1 in. (2.5 cm) high
Roughly-bleached, strongly ridged shell is as wide as it is high.



Filled Dogwhelk (W)

Neverita lineatella
To 3 in. (8 cm)
Brown to white shell has footy oval holes and spines. Species found in quieter waters have smoother shells. Found in intertidal waters.



Bleeding Tooth (CR)

Nassa purpurata
To 1.5 in. (4 cm) high
Craggy shell has black and red streaks that a blood-like stain near its teeth.

Thick Spined Oyster Drill (E)

Littorina saxatilis
To 1.5 in. (4 cm) high
Small shell has a pointed spine and spiral ridges. Feeds primarily on oysters.



Marsh Periwinkle (CR,V)

Littorina maritima
To 1 in. (2 cm) high
Grayish-white, sculpted shell has low spiral ridges. Common in marshes and estuaries.



Checkered Periwinkle (W)

Littorina saxatilis
To 3 in. (7.5 cm) high
Smooth brownish shell has rows of white spots.



Angulate Winklesnail (V,CR)

Epitonium angulatum
To 1 in. (2.5 cm) high
Shell has 8-10 sharp, blade-like ribs.



Common Periwinkle (B,V)

Littorina littorea
To 1 in. (2 cm)
Gray to brown rounded shell has a low spine and fine spiral ridges. Feeds up to 6' in water. Found in estuarine waters.



Purple Dwarf Olive (W)

Urosalpinx olivacea
To 1.5 in. (4 cm) high
Smooth shell has a conical spine. Color varies from purple to white and brown. Carnivorous scavenger feeds on animal remains. Shells were used by Native Americans in jewelry.



Lettered Olive (CR, CB)

Olivella leucostoma
To 2.5 in. (6 cm)
Olive yellow to grayish cylindrical shell has markings that resemble lettering. Southern Carolina's state shell.



Atlantic Deer Cowrie (CR,CB)

Margaritana deusta
To 7 in. (18 cm)
Large, brown shiny oval shell is white-spotted. Note prominent teeth lining central opening.



Three-lined Nassia (E)

Nassarius trilineatus
To 1 in. (2 cm) high
Whitish shell has 4-6 beaded spiral ridges. Southern specimens often have 3 spiraling red brown lines.



Johnstone's Junonia (CR, CB)

Isapelta junonia johnstoniana
To 3 in. (7.5 cm)
Deep water Gulf Coast shell only reaches up on shore after storm surges. Alabama's state shell.



Channeled Nassia (CA)

Nassarius trilineatus
To 2 in. (5 cm) high
Large yellow-brown to yellow-gray shell has deep, beaded ridges and a pointed spine.

Foliate Thornmouth (W)

Cerastoma foliosum
To 3.5 in. (9 cm) high
Shell has three large, leaf-like flanges. Color varies from white to dark brown depending on location.



Lace Murex (CR)

Chamaelea striatula
To 1 in. (2.5 cm)
Elatebrate shell with white to brownish shell with long ribs.



Apple Murex (CR)

Chamaelea pumila
To 4.5 in. (11 cm)
Yellow-white to brownish shell has raised ribs but lacks long spines. Faint brown spots on outer lip of shell.



Carinate Downshell (W)

Alia carinata
To 3 in. (7.5 cm) high
Small shell has a pointed spine. Inside are pinkish white. Common in shallow water.



California Cone (CAS)

Conus californicus
To 1.5 in. (4 cm) high
Smooth brownish shell has a low spine. A carnivorous species that preys on prey with a harpoon-like tooth that injects poison. Do not handle live specimens.



California Horn Snail (CAS)

Caudofoveate californicus
To 1.8 in. (4.5 cm)
Spiral high-spired shell is common on intertidal flats in estuaries and bays. Can climb trees and let out of water for extended periods.



Alphabet Cone (CR)

Conus spiralis
To 3 in. (8 cm)
Creamy shell has bands of red-brown splotches. Shows a hole deeper out of the narrow end of the shell.



Solitary Glassy Bubble (V)

Hydrobia ulvae
To .75 in. (2 cm)
Very fragile white to pinkish shell has a delicate lip. Shells are so light they are often transported to the highest tide line.



Common Fig Shell (CR)

Alia columbata
To 2 in. (5 cm)
Elatebrate, cream to light brown, pear-shaped shell has five spiral cords. Often washed up at the highest tide line.
