

HOW TO START A LUCET CORD

Starting a LUCET cord will seem a little tricky at first. With very little practice, it will become simple—honest it will! Good Videos are on-line. Google "lucet video."



Step 1.

Start as shown. At this point, the yarn has been brought across both prongs after a little figure 8 step in the beginning.



Step 2.

The bottom yarn is lifted over the top yarn and over the right prong. You are moving toward your first knot, but that's a little ways away.



Step 3.

At this point, the first stage of the first knot is loosely taking shape. Keep that loose beginning of a knot more or less in the center between the prongs. Turn the LUCET over, always flipping over to the left.



Step 4.

You are now looking at the back side (no logo). Bring the yarn straight across both prongs and above the other yarn. Again, lift the bottom yarn over the straight top yarn and over the right prong. This is always the same move.



Step 5. Take up the slack a little, center the loose knot. Turn the LUCET over to the left.

Step 6. Again bring the yarn straight across both prongs. Lift the bottom yarn over the straight yarn and the right prong. Tighten the centered knot. Turn the LUCET over.



Step 7 and onward.

Repeat—yarn straight across both prongs, lift bottom yarn over top yarn and right prong; tighten the center knot as you do so. Turn LUCET over and repeat. A cord of knots will begin to emerge. As cord grows longer, feed it down through the hole.
