


During postnatal development properties of circadian rhythms in the SCN and its inputs and outputs can be modulated by environmental light conditions Recent optical manipulation and imaging techniques have revealed that cell type specific functions for circadian rhythms However it remains unclear which cell types or networks in the brain are modulated during postnatal development and how these cells regulate circadian rhythms depending on postnatal period
